The role will be based on, and require travel between, construction sites initially situated around the motorway network between Birmingham and Gloucester. A full driving licence is essential and suitable candidates should reside within a suitable daily travel distance.

The role will be largely based outdoors, working in various weather conditions and accessing various parts of site, including ground level and scaffolding at height.

The successful candidate will take part in the following:

- Supporting a Senior Quantity Surveyor
- Collating data on our construction sites using various methods
- Producing reports from data collected to be submitted to the Senior Quantity Surveyor
- Training in measurement of quantities (materials, works, resource etc.)
- Use of measurement tools, manual systems and IT packages
- Liason with site teams - Engineers, Managers etc.

The apprenticeship is open to applicants that already possess A Level qualifications, preferably in Mathematics, Science or Design related subjects.

It is intended that following completion of the Apprenticeship and an NVQ Qualification the successful applicant will pursue a higher qualification on a part time basis, whilst continuing to learn 'on the job'.

Applicants must hold a full driving license as travel between sites will be a requirement of the role.

A company vehicle may be provided and the employment package will include private healthcare, pension and income protection.
